Establish a district account

To register for camp, a pre-established account must be set up prior to camp registration. See page 26 for further details.

Remember your Login and Password

Make sure you know your login and password if you plan to register online. If you do not remember your login or password visit **skokieparks.org** and click on the register tab, go to My Account and select 'Forgot Username?', or 'Forgot Password?'

Check your account

Confirm that your park district account is updated and correct and that all children are listed on the account with the correct birth dates.

Registration by Age

Camp enrollment is based on age. Campers must be the appropriate age for each camp by September 1, 2024. See page 4-5 for all camps listed by age.

Registration: In-Person

Starting February 4 at noon, walk-in registration will be available at the Devonshire Cultural Center, Emily Oaks Nature Center, Oakton Community Center, Weber Leisure Center, and Skatium Ice Arena.

Registration: Online

Starting February 4 at noon, online registration will be available to customers with a pre-established park district account. See left for instructions on how to set up an account.

Make a list

For easy reference, create a list of all of the camps you plan to register for ahead of time, include activity and section numbers. You can also use the wish list feature once logged into your park district account. Do not add camps to your cart ahead of registration. Instead, move the camps (one at a time) from your wish list to your cart to purchase.

Have a backup plan!

Camp capacities are limited. Popular camps fill to capacity on the first day of registration. Camps that filled to capacity on the first day of registration for 2023 are marked with ... Have a back up plan if your first choice fills and/or put your child on the waitlist. Supervisors will be in contact if a spot becomes available.

Have payment ready

Payment options are: pay in full, auto-debit installment plan, or fee assistance. See page 26 for more information.

Complete forms

Each child requires a Camper Information Form once registration is completed. To fill out the form, visit our website at skokieparks.org. Click 'Register' and enter your username and password. Then click on Camper Information Form (CIF), select your camper's name, and complete or change the CIF.
