



Tennis Court Fencing Project

Bid Deadline: January 31, 2025 at 10 a.m.

The Skokie Park District will receive bids for the 2025 Tennis Court Fencing project beginning January 16 at the Park Services Center after 9 a.m. Bids are also available electronically by calling the Skokie Park District at (847) 929-7800. The scope of work includes provision and installation of tennis court fencing at Gleiss Park and Lorel Park located at 9301 Keystone Ave., and 8135 Lorel Ave., respectively. Bids shall be sealed in an envelope clearly marked Skokie District, 2025 Tennis Court Fencing Project and delivered to the Park Services at 7500 Frontage Road, Skokie, IL 60077. Bids will be received until exactly 10 a.m. Friday, January 31 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Skokie Park District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any technicalities in the bidding if it should be deemed in the public's best interest.

The work of this project is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq. A prevailing wage determination has been made for the Park District by IDOL for public works projects in Cook County. The contract entered into for the work will be drawing in compliance with said law and proposals should be prepared accordingly and provide payment for all laborers, workmen and mechanics needed to perform the work at no less than the prevailing rate of wages for each craft, type of worker or mechanic.
